| General | - A dress code appropriate top and bottom must be worn at all times <br> - Clothing must be worn such that undergarments are not visible at any time | - Anything with rips, holes, tears, fringes, or unfinished edges <br> - Any clothing item that is faded to the point where the color differs from the intended color <br> - Excessively tight or baggy clothing <br> - Hoodies <br> - Pajamas or similar garment <br> - Jackets, coats, parkas, ponchos of any kind in the instructional environment <br> - Any bottoms that do not fit well at the waist <br> - Any clothing that is intended to show undergarments <br> - Any clothing, jewelry, or style of grooming that is identified with membership in a gang <br> - Apparel advertising/depicting alcohol, tobacco products, illegal/controlled substances, and/or offensives sayings or innuendo <br> - Permanent tattoos worn uncovered <br> - Drawing on the skin with any writing utensils |
| Tops | - A solid color polo shirt in navy, burgundy, white or cream, plain or with Vanguard logo or approved Vanguard text; <br> - An opaque button up dress shirt in school colors <br> - Undershirts of a solid color in black, dark blue, gray, tan, or school colors | - V-neck, T-shirts, or Tank Tops <br> - Shirts with patterns on them <br> - Shirts with other logos or non-approved Vanguard text <br> - Tops with embellishments including beads, rhinestones, and bedazzling <br> - Pajamas or similar garment <br> - Hoodies <br> - Logos other than the Vanguard logos |
| Sweatshirts and Sweaters | - A crew neck sweatshirt that is in school colors <br> - A solid color sweater in black, gray, or school colors (maroon, navy/dark blue, khaki/tan, white) | - HOODIES <br> - Outerwear of any kind including rain coats, winter coats, windbreakers, fleece jackets, and other coats |
| Bottoms | - Solid colored pants in dark blue, black, or khaki <br> - Solid colored skirts, shorts, skorts, or jumpers in dark blue, black, khaki, or school colors that are within 3 " of the knee when standing <br> - Bottoms must fit well at the waist and remain there when walking <br> - Bottoms must be loose enough that they move at the knee when walking | - Leggings or athletic pants as the sole bottom <br> - Sweatpants <br> - Overalls <br> - Bottoms with patterns on them <br> - Bottoms with embellishments, including beads, rhinestones, and bedazzling <br> - Cargo pockets on bottoms or pockets that are below the waist level <br> - Athletic shorts underneath pants that become visible when moving or standing <br> - Jeans or denim <br> - Joggers with drawstring waist and elastic ankles <br> - Pajamas or similar garments |

| Socks and Hosiery | - Socks of any solid color or pattern <br> - Leggings or tights worn underneath dress code appropriate bottoms must be in good repair | - Socks with pants tucked into them |
| Shoes | - Close-toed shoes in any color including athletic shoes, close-toed flats, and boots <br> - Shoes must be worn at all times <br> - Shoes must be a matched pair | - Sandals of any kind <br> - High-heeled shoes with more than $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ heels <br> - Shoes with bells or other distracting adornments <br> - Slippers or other shoes not intended to be worn outside <br> - Snow boots worn indoors <br> - "Boots" that are made with slipper material and have a slipper bottom <br> - Boots that come above the knee are prohibited |
| Accessories | - Piercings or earrings in the ear that are no larger than a quarter <br> - A single nose stud or ring in the side of the nose (ring must not exceed 16 gauge in size) <br> - Ties in solid colors or patterns worn properly at the neck | - Visible piercings anywhere (except the ears and nostrils) including lip, tongue, eyebrow, and septum <br> - Distracting makeup and/or nails <br> - Scarves <br> - Ties in distracting patterns or with licensed characters or symbols <br> - Sunglasses worn indoors <br> - Animal chains/collars or tails <br> - Unnatural colored contacts |
| Headwear and Hair | - Religious head coverings of any color/pattern <br> - Barrettes, hair ties, and plain headbands worn in the hair | - Hats of any kind including athletic/baseball caps, berets, winter hats, trilbies, Bandanas, or fedoras <br> - Athletic type headbands <br> - Head coverings other than religious headgear |
